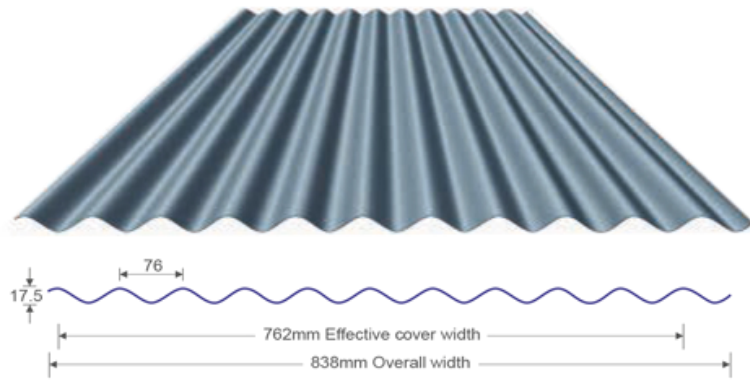

The Classicorr corrugated® profile is sinusoidal and can be used as both roofing and cladding material. With its origins dating back to the Victorian era, it is probably the most commonly known sheeting profile used in the world today. The fact that corrugated profiled sheeting has been around since before the turn of the century proves that this easy to use and effective profile for roofing and wall cladding is here to stay.

Classicorr Corrugated® sheets can be factory cranked, curved and bullnosed to a wide range of radii. For further details refer to page 18 of this manual or contact the Safintra Technical Department.



LENGTHS & ROOF PITCH

Classicorr Corrugated® sheeting can be ordered in any length, subject to transport limitations, up to 13,2m. Longer lengths require special transport arrangements.

When using Classicorr Corrugated® sheeting the recommended minimum roof slope (pitch) for sheets longer than 15m is 15°, and for sheets shorter than 15m the minimum roof slope is 10°.
